

Off Licence

Section 17 to 20, 64 and 135, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **Glengarry Wines Limited** (the licensee) is authorised to sell or deliver alcohol on or from the premises situated at **420 New North Road, Kingsland, Auckland** and known as **Glengarry Kingsland**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day.
- (b) **Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 8.00am to 11.00pm**
- (c) Drinking water is to be freely available to customers while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample on the premises and signage directing people to drinking water must be prominently displayed on the premises at that time.
- (d) The fees payable for the licensing of the premises concerned are the following risk rating: **High**
- (e) The whole of the premises are designated as a supervised area.
- (f) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - (i) Ensure that no intoxicated persons are allowed to enter or to remain on the premises.
 - (ii) Ensure that appropriate signs are prominently displayed detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of liquor to minors and intoxicated persons, at each entry and adjacent to every point of sale.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) either—
 - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either—
 - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
